

ORDINANCE NO. 984

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70, TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY PROHIBITING INGRESS AND EGRESS TO AND FROM THE GARDENS OF HOLLYWOOD PARK BY LARGE TRUCKS**

WHEREAS, large trucks entering and exiting the Gardens of Hollywood Park have caused significant property damage to improvements and landscaping in the Gardens of Hollywood Park because the access points to such subdivision were not designed to accommodate ingress and egress by large trucks.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS that Chapter 70, Traffic and Motor Vehicles, is amended by adopting a new Section 70-38 as follows:

**“Sec. 70-38. Limitation on Access to the Gardens of Hollywood Park**

It shall be unlawful for any person, directly or through an agent, servant, or employee, to enter or exit the Gardens of Hollywood Park while operating a truck tractor attached to a semitrailer as those terms are defined in Section 541.201 of the Texas Transportation Code, which truck tractor and semitrailer have a manufacturer’s rated carrying capacity of more than 25,000 pounds. Signs shall be installed at all entries to the Gardens of Hollywood Park warning the public and large truck operators of the restrictions contained in this ordinance. The sign wording shall be approved by the Police Chief and Mayor.

It shall furthermore be unlawful for any person, directly or through an agent, servant or employee, to aid or assist a person entering or exiting the Gardens of Hollywood Park while operating a truck tractor attached to a semitrailer which is described in the preceding paragraph.

This ordinance shall become effective five days after its publication and after the posting of the signs described hereinabove.
