

**ORDINANCE NO. 850**

**AN ORDINANCE CANCELLING THE MAY 10, 2008  
GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE TOWN OF  
HOLLYWOOD PARK AND DECLARING EACH  
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park called a General Election to be held on May 10, 2008 for the purpose of electing Mayor, Councilmen to City Council Places Two, and Four, and;


**WHEREAS**, at the close of the official filing period for an application for a place on the ballot all candidates were unopposed and no applications for write-in candidacy were filed, and;

**WHEREAS**, Texas Election Code, Subchapter C., Election of Unopposed Candidates, Sections 2.051 through 2.054 allows for the cancellation of an election where candidates are unopposed and further allows that by ordinance the City Council may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS** that the May 10, 2008 General Election for the Town of Hollywood Park, Texas for the purpose of electing Mayor, Councilmen to City Council Places Two, and Four be canceled and each unopposed candidate is declared elected to office:


Mayor	-	Richard McIlveen
