

ORDINANCE NO. 885

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK
CODE OF ORDINANCE SECTION 70-77 PROHIBITING PARKING
BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2:00 AM AND 5:00 AM**

WHEREAS, the Town of Hollywood Park, has an Ordinance prohibiting the parking of cars, trucks, commercial vehicles, truck trailers, trailers, boats, recreational vehicles, campers, mobile homes and other vehicles on public streets and public easements or public right-of-ways adjacent to residentially zoned property between the hours of 2:00 AM and 5:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that the prohibition eases traffic congestion, ensures unfettered access of emergency vehicles to residences during the overnight hours, and foster safe egress for residents leaving their homes in the early hours; and

WHEREAS, since the enactment of the Ordinance, the Town has determined that oversized vehicles, such as commercial vehicles, truck tractors, trailers, boats, and recreational vehicles including travel trailers, campers, and motor homes, pose the greatest impediment to public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that permitting passenger cars and trucks to be parked on residential streets overnight, without a permit, does not undermine public safety in the Town of Hollywood Park; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

The Town of Hollywood Park Town Council hereby amends the Town of Hollywood Park Code of Ordinances Section 70-77 prohibiting parking between the hours of 2:00 AM and 5:00 AM as follows:

Sec. 70-77. Prohibited parking between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.

(a) *Prohibitions.* The parking of commercial vehicles, truck tractors, all trailers, boats, recreational vehicles (RVs), including travel trailers, campers, or motor homes upon a public street, public easement or public right-of-way adjacent to a residentially zoned property between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. is prohibited. This provision shall not apply to a temporarily disabled vehicle; provided that the temporarily disabled vehicle is protected by an approved emergency safety signal device.

(b) *Penalty.*


Any person violating any of the provisions or terms of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished according to the general penalties described in section 1-15. Each and every violation or day such violation shall continue or exist shall be deemed a separate offense.


