

TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK **ORDINANCE NO. 898**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 2-56
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK
RELATING TO OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN

WHEREAS Texas Local Government Code Section 22.071 provides the governing body of the municipality with authority regarding appointment and management of officers and agents of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Article III, Section 2-56 of the Code of the Town of Hollywood Park presently provides that the City Council shall appoint certain listed municipal officers to perform the work of the Town of Hollywood Park municipal government under the direction and supervision of the city council and who shall be appointed for an indefinite period and shall be subject to discharge at the will of the City Council;

AND WHEREAS it is an important function of the governmental process that the elected governing body of the Town of Hollywood Park exercise supervision of the key municipal employees charged with carrying out the policies of the Town;

AND WHEREAS certain clarification of Section 2-56 is necessary for the proper administration of the Town of Hollywood Park;

IT IS NOW, THEREFORE, ORDAINED that Section 2-56 of the Code of the Town of Hollywood Park is amended as follows:

Sec. 2-56 Appointment of other officers and term of office.

(A.) The city council shall appoint the below-listed officers who shall perform the work of the municipal government under the direction and supervision of the city council

and who shall be appointed for an indefinite period and shall be subject to discharge at the will of the City Council. It is permissible that more than one listed position may be held and the functions performed by the same individual.

- (1) **Building official/inspector.**
- (2) **City administrator.**
- (3) **City attorney.**
- (4) **City engineer.**
- (5) **City finance officer.**
- (6) **City secretary.**
- (7) **Code compliance officer.**
- (8) **Fire chief.**
- (9) **Fire marshal.**
- (10) **Health authority.**
- (11) **Health inspector.**
- (12) **Municipal court judge.**
- (13) **Police chief.**
- (14) **Public works foreman.**
- (15) **Tax collector.**

(B.) The titles of the positions listed in subsection A, above, denominate the municipal function of the person holding that position or positions. In the event that a job title differs as a result of administrative usage or practice, the authority of the City Council under subsection A of this ordinance shall extend to any individual charged with performing the listed function without regard to any other title denominated.


