
AN ORDINANCE NAMING TRIANGLE PARK AS MEMORIAL PARK IN HONOR OF FORMER MAYOR WILLIAM "BILL" BOHLKE AND ALL THE OTHERS WHO HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK

WHEREAS, the park now known as Triangle Park was dedicated to the public on or about June 21, 1951 as part of the Hollywood Park Addition, Unit 1, plat of 62.118 acres out of the J. H. Glassen Survey No.15, which plat was signed by W. H. Barnes, Walter W. Glassen and Linda Glassen; and

WHEREAS, the park dedication referred to hereinabove did not assign a name to the park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS that the above referenced park is hereby named Memorial Park in honor of former Mayor William "Bill" Bohlke and all the others who have contributed to the Town of Hollywood Park and the City Secretary is authorized to install appropriate signage in the park and city reflecting the new name of the park.


