

**AN ORDINANCE CANCELLING THE MAY 11, 2013
GENERAL/SPECIAL/JOINT ELECTION FOR THE TOWN OF
HOLLYWOOD PARK AND DECLARING EACH
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park called a General Election to be held on May 11, 2013 for the purpose of electing members to City Council Places One, Three and Five; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park called a Special Election to be held on May 11, 2013 for the purpose of electing a Mayor; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the official filing period for an application for a place on the ballot all candidates were unopposed and no applications for write-in candidacy were filed; and

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code, Subchapter C., Election of Unopposed Candidates, Sections 2.051 through 2.054 allows for the cancellation of an election where candidates are unopposed and further allows that by ordinance the City Council may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS that the May 11, 2013 General/Special/Joint Election for the Town of Hollywood Park, Texas for the purpose of electing a Mayor and members to City Council Places One, Three and Four be canceled and each unopposed candidate is declared elected to office:

Mayor	-	David L. Ortega, for a term to expire after the 2014 General Election
City Council Place One	-	Steve Phillips
City Council Place Three	-	Chris Fails
City Council Place Five	-	Holly McBrayer


