

ORDINANCE NO. 944

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 72 TREES AND PUBLIC TREE CARE BY REPEALING SECTION 72-14 (1) b REGARDING REMOVAL OF DEBRIS AND ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 72-14 (1) B APPLICABLE TO TREE CONTRACTORS ONLY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park adopted Ordinance #943 on June 17, 2014 which addressed oak tree care in the Town of Hollywood Park; and

WHEREAS, Section 72-14 (1) b of said ordinance required residents, proprietors and tree contractors to remove oak tree debris within 96 hours; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park desires to remove the requirement in Section 72-14 (1) b that residents and proprietors remove oak tree debris within 96 hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS that Chapter 72 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Hollywood Park is hereby amended by repealing Section 72-14 (1) b and by adopting the following Section 72-14 (1) b in its place:

“Sec. 72-14. Management/Enforcement.

(1) Code Compliance

b. All debris resulting from the cutting/trimming of oaks by Tree Contractors shall be removed by the Tree Contractor who created the debris from the town within 96 hours of the cutting/trimming. This provision does not affect or modify the requirement in Section 72-14 (2) b that dead Red Oak tree removal must occur within 96 hours after plan submission.”

This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication according to law.
