

ORDINANCE NO. 945

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING CERTAIN FEES FOR THE COLLECTION OF SANITARY SEWAGE IN THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the current charges for the collection of sanitary sewage in the town are insufficient to pay the costs of maintaining the sewer system and the charges of the San Antonio Water System for the treatment of sanitary sewage generated in the city.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS, that Ordinance No. 418 is amended by increasing rates as follows:

“Section 1 (a) Inside City Limits

0 to 1,496 gallons of water	Minimum charge \$14.33 per month
Over 1,496 gallons of water	\$0.3795 per 100 gallons

The unaveraged residential charge Inside City Limits in Section 1 (b) is increased to \$39.87.

The unmetered residential charge Inside City Limits in Section 1 (b) is increased to \$39.87.

The I.C.L. charge of \$25.00 is increased to \$39.87 in Subsection (c) of “Methods for Adjusting Monthly Residential Charges”.

The General Service Inside City Limits (Net Rate) in Section 1(f) is increased as follows:

General Service Inside City Limits (Net Rate)

0 to 1,496 gallons of water	Minimum charge \$14.33 per month
Over 1,496 gallons of water	\$0.3795 per 100 gallons”

The rates provided herein shall be effective for all billing cycles after the effective date of this Ordinance.


