

# HYDRANT TESTING

153 Fire Hydrants in Hollywood Park



The Hollywood Park Fire Department conducts inspection and testing of all hydrants within the city limits once a year. This includes flowing each hydrant, oiling outlet threads and visual inspection for damage and leaks. All issues are reported to SAWS for repairs.

# HOSE TESTING



- The fire department has 165 sections of fire hose that is tested yearly.
- We have 50' and 100' sections of hose totaling 7800 feet (approximately 1.5 miles of hose).
- All hose is tested in-house by our firefighters in accordance to National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1962 standards.

# Insurance Service Offices (ISO) Rating

- Our fire department obtained a **Class 4** fire rating from the Texas Department of Insurance, State Fire Marshal's Office. (1 being the best, 10 being the worst)
- This rating has helped some residents lower the cost of their homeowners insurance.
- Lowering our rating took several years to obtain and required numerous hours of preparation by ALL members of the department.



# 2015 Challenges

- ❖ Upgrade our fire station software in an effort to go completely paperless for reports writing, inventory, pre-plans, inspections and testing.
- ❖ Continue to upgrade or vehicle fleet by replacing vehicles that are over 10 years old.
- ❖ Request approval from Bexar-Bulverde Fire Department to utilize their new bunker gear cleaner and extractor and send one member of each shift to school to become a certified Structural Firefighting Gear inspector. This will save the city the cost of having to take our gear to Austin for inspection and cleaning once a year as required by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection
