

ORDINANCE NO. 1009

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK,
TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 72, TREES AND PUBLIC
TREE CARE, BY REVISING SUBSECTION 72-13 (5).**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park adopted Ordinance #943 on June 17, 2014 which addressed oak tree care in the Town of Hollywood Park; and

WHEREAS, Subsections 72-13 (3) and 72-13 (4) of Chapter 72, Trees and Public Tree Care, were amended by ordinance #960 on April 21, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 72-13 (5) of Chapter 72, Trees and Public Tree Care, was adopted by the City Council of the Town of Hollywood Park by Ordinance No. _____ on February 21, 2017 to authorize unrestricted removal of oak trees in the "Red Zone".

WHEREAS, the City Council desire to further amend Subsection 72-13 (5).


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK, TEXAS that Chapter 72 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Hollywood Park is hereby amended by amending subsection 72- 13 (5) to read as follows:

"Sec. 72-13. Preventive Measures.

(5) Oak Tree Removal Unrestricted in "Red Zone"

Any species of oak trees may be removed or pruned from private property at any time in an area of the town referred to as the "Red Zone". The location of the "Red Zone" is stated in an official map or chart maintained in the office of the City Secretary. The Tree Committee shall be responsible for producing the "Red Zone" map or chart. A person desiring to remove or prune any oak tree from within the "Red Zone" shall first obtain a permit for such work as provided in Subsection 72-13 (2) of the Code of Ordinances.


