HOLLYWOOD PARK, TX – March 16, 2020 – The Town of Hollywood Park is taking proactive measures to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), including limiting in-person interactions for city business and suspending court for the month of April.

The Town of Hollywood Park will continue to provide all city services. We are also actively encouraging city business be handled online or via phone where possible. These measures are being taken out of an abundance of caution in an effort to protect the public health, particularly our most vulnerable populations, and to slow the progression of this virus, which in turn eases the burden on medical care providers. Preserving the health and safety of our staff allows essential city services to continue without interruptions.

We are constantly monitoring and assessing the situation. City staff will continue reporting to work unless an employee is sick. While we are discouraging large public gatherings, we do encourage your continued support of local businesses. Remember to follow these preventative measures in your daily life: • Wash your hands frequently • Stay at home if you're sick • Avoid close personal contact, such as shaking hands • Disinfect surfaces.
