

ORDINANCE NO. 2001

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO OBTAIN EXEMPT LICENSE PLATES FOR THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK CITY OWNED VEHICLES BY ADOPTING SECTION 2-5 OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Town of Hollywood Park is a Type A general-law municipality in Bexar County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Code, chapter 721 allows certain Town owned vehicles to obtain exemptions for registrations; and

WHEREAS Title 43 of the Texas Administrative Code, Section 217.55-Exempt and Alias Vehicle Registration, provides certain requirements to obtain exempt status for vehicles; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain such exemptions and relieve the Town's burden for payment, the governing body of the Town must authorize the exemption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is a need to have such vehicles with such exemptions to protect the general health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Hollywood Park.

I.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOLLYWOOD PARK that the Town Council adopts Section 2-5 of the Town of Hollywood Park Code of Ordinances which shall state as follows:

Sec. 2-5 Authorization for Exempt Vehicles

The Town authorizes the Town own vehicles which qualify for state exemptions, including registration, to be exempt as permitted by law. The mayor, or the mayor's designee, is authorized to sign any application or document seeking exemptions from state requirements for Town own vehicles.

II.

CUMULATIVE CLAUSE

That this Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of the Town of Hollywood Park except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such Ordinance, in which event the conflicting provisions of such Ordinance are hereby repealed.

III.

SEVERABILITY AND SAVINGS CLAUSE

That it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Town Council of the Town of Hollywood Park that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance should be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of the Ordinances, since the same would have been enacted by the Town Council without incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrases, sentences, paragraphs, or sections.



EFFECTIVE DATE**


This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by state and local law. Passed by the Town Council of the Town of Hollywood Park this the 22nd day of July 2020.


