- 1. Fire Department monthly report
 - Fire Chief Butrico reported 47 calls for service in October. Chief Butrico announced the completion of the fire bay extension project and the Santa Parade on December 17.
- 2. Police Department monthly report
 - Chief Prichard reported 472 calls for service, 563 total citations, and recognized several officers for their years of service. Patrick Aten swore in police officer Caballero.
