## **Street Maintenance Sales Tax Reauthorization**

Although there will be no contested races for Mayor or City Council, voters will see one important item on the ballot. A Special Election will be held in conjunction with the May 2, 2026 General Election for the purpose of voting on the reauthorization of one-quarter percent (0.25%) of the local sales and use tax dedicated to the continued maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

The Town of Hollywood Park received formal notice from the State Comptroller's Office that approval of an ordinance is required in order to proceed with a vote on retaining the one-quarter percent (0.25%) sales and use tax dedicated to street maintenance. This proposition does not create a new tax. It allows voters to decide whether to continue the existing allocation that supports street maintenance, repairs, and long-term infrastructure planning throughout our community.

Even in years without contested races, ballot propositions have a meaningful impact on the future of our Town. We encourage all eligible residents to participate in the May 2, 2026 election.
